Field of scope

- **Pathological Anatomy Service (AP):** research and analysis related to general pathology and veterinary pathological anatomy.
- **Anatomy and Physiology Service (ANFI):** research and analysis relating to anatomy, physiology and translational research.
- **Bioscience and Biotechnology Service (BSBT):** research and analysis relating to: chemistry, biochemistry, cell and molecular biology, pharmacology and toxicology, translational research.
- **Communicable Diseases and Public Veterinary Health Service (MTSPV):** research and activities related to communicable diseases and public veterinary health for the protection and promotion of human and animal health; study of transmissible agents and insights related to the etiology, epidemiology, pathogenesis, diagnosis, treatment, prevention and control of diseases, in particular zoonoses.
- **Exotic and Wildlife Service (SEFSE):** research and activities related to the ecology of pathogens with special focus on climate and environmental changes. Health and population management of wildlife. Diagnostics applied to wild and exotic species. Medicine, surgery and treatment of exotic animals and wildlife.
- **Animal Products and Food Safety Services (SPASA):** research and activities relating to: genetics and genetic improvement, food, nutrition and feeding, technology and hygiene of farms, animal welfare and quality of animal products, safety in animal source foods supply chains, agricultural economics. Including the **Fish Production Unit (PROIT)** Cesenatico Centre.
- **Central Drugs Service (SFC):** activities of support to the Department through drugs purchase management, medical aid posts, safeguard of the regulations regarding the use of drugs and authorisations of the health authorities.
- **Administrative Service (SA):** activities related to the administrative and accounting management of the Department.
- **Anaesthesia and Intensive Care and Resuscitation Service (SANE):** research and activities related to anaesthesia and intensive care and resuscitation.
- **Equine Clinical Service (SERE):** research and activities related to surgery, internal medicine, emergency medicine and reproduction of equines.
- **Poultry pathology service (SEPAV):** research and activities related to poultry diseases; focusing on their etiology, epidemiology, pathogenesis, diagnosis and control, studied by both traditional or innovative methods.
- **Diagnostic imaging service (SDIMM):** research and activities related to the diagnostic and interventional/therapeutic application of procedures that use ionizing radiations (Conventional radiology and Computed tomography), ultrasonic waves (Ultrasound), magnetic fields (Magnetic resonance imaging), and radioactive substances (Nuclear medicine).
- **Clinical pathology service (CLINLAB):** research and activities focused on the development, application and interpretation of diagnostic laboratory procedures for the diagnosis, prognosis, treatment and the monitoring of animal diseases.
- **Clinical Service for large and small ruminants (BUIATRIA):** research and activities related to bovine, sheep and goat medicine.
- **Small Animal Clinical Service (SERCLIPA):** research and activities related to small animal emergency medicine, internal medicine, reproduction and surgery.
